RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Standards of Conduct of Fair General Rules and Regulations of Dutchess County Fair and General Rules of Dutchess County Fair Horse Show are available on request and also will be posted for your review on the day of the show.
2. Loss, injury or damage to horse or owner (including driver/handler or other employee) is in no way the responsibility of the Dutchess County Fair Management or the Horse Show Committee.
3. Entries close 10 days prior to the Dutchess County Fair Draft Horse Show. Post entries will be accepted with \$10 overall fee. Make checks payable to Dutchess County Fair
4. At no time will horses be allowed to be driven on any vehicle in areas of the fairgrounds where the fair management has not previously granted permission to do so.
5. Numbers must be visible in the ring
6. In all halter and hitch/driving classes horse or horses must be sound. In hitch/driving classes horse or horses shall be shown hitched to a suitable vehicle and the driver shall be clean and neatly dressed.
7. In all hitch/driving classes, the driver will be allowed one helper, no other riders will be permitted on the wagon while the horses are being shown. In any driving classes where more than two horses are shown, two capable drivers must be on the wagon.
8. In driving classes where more than two horses are shown they may be owned by one or more exhibitor. Be sure only one entry is made for each hitch.
9. Insufficient entries in a class shall result in the cancellation of that class. The Judge and Ringmaster reserve the right to divide, combine or add any classes it deems necessary for the good of the show.
10. Junior's age will be determined as of January 1 in the year of show. Junior to drive classes will be judged on driving ability and not on the quality of horses. All juniors must be accompanied by an adult capable of driving horses. Juniors may not show a stallion in any class.
11. **NEW YORK STATE HELMET LAW: Article 34-B. S1265 No person less than fourteen years of age shall ride/drive a horse/horses unless such person is wearing a helmet meeting or exceeding ASTM F1163 (Safety Equipment Institute certified) Equestrian Standard.**
12. Farm teams may not be shown in hitch classes, and hitch teams may not be shown in farm classes - no scotch collars or scotch shoes in all farm classes.
13. Hitch/driving classes will be judged according to quality of horses, equipment and the ability of the driver to handle his/her horses at the command of the judge. An uncontrollable horse/s may be excused at any time by the discretion of the judge or ringmaster.
14. Entrants for the North American Classic Six Series should be under one name only. At least four of the six horses must be owned by the registrant.
15. The Fair superintendents or management may deny admission to, or require segregation or removal from Fair premises any animal found to be infected with or exposed to any communicable disease whether internal or external and whether or not such disease is specifically mentioned in these regulations, if in his opinion such action is necessary for the protection of other exhibits.
16. In the registered classes, all registration papers must be available if requested.
17. The Dutchess County Agricultural Society shall reserve the right to reject or refuse and to order the removal of any exhibit which, in the opinion of its board of directors is not eligible or worthy of showing or has not met the livestock health requirements.
18. Stalls are on a first-come, first-serve basis.
19. **ALL HORSES ENTERING THE FAIRGROUNDS MUST MEET NEW YORK STATE HEALTH REQUIREMENTS. OUT OF STATE HORSES MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY HEALTH CERTIFICATES. ALL HORSES MUST HAVE A CERTIFICATE OF COGGINS TEST PERFORMED IN THE CURRENT OR PREVIOUS CALENDAR YEAR. ALSO REQUIRED IS PROOF OF A CURRENT RABIES VACCINATION.**
20. A \$25.00 charge will be incurred for any returned checks.
