

## OPEN CLASS DAIRY GOAT SHOW

### Rules – Entries Close August 1st - Check-in for goats is Monday, August 24, 2020 at 7pm.

Before making entries, read Standard No 350.0 in the Exhibitor Guide, Rules and Regulations of the Department of Agriculture and Markets, and Part 351, Livestock Health Requirements.

### This is an officially sanctioned ADGA Junior & Open Doe Show.

1. Entries close August 1st. Entries will be accepted on a date received basis MAXIMUM 150 GOATS. If no space is available, you will be notified. All entries must be made on official entry forms. Payment in full must accompany entry blanks or entries will not be accepted. The Entry Office will keep a wait list.
2. All entries must be in place by Monday August 24th. 8PM, and remain until 8 PM on Sunday unless early release is approved by management.
3. Each exhibitor must present to the Show Secretary proof of registration prior to the start of the show and be compliant with health requirements.
4. Exhibitors in the department will be limited to not more than twelve animals (12) animals per exhibitor, and two (2) animals per class.
5. All does selected as Grand Champion will be entered in class 10 (Champion Challenge). Anyone with a doe qualifying for this class will be required to pay the \$5.00 entry fee at end of show.
6. Only one entry per exhibitor will be allowed in all group classes.
7. ADGA Rules shall govern. The show order is subject to change.
8. ADGA registration or recordation of all animals six months of age or older is required, kids under six months of age may be shown with proof that application for registration or recordation has been received by the ADGA office, this must be a stamped duplicate, Faxes will not be allowed.
9. NO bucks of any age will be allowed.
10. NO shorts or inappropriate tops to be worn in show ring.
11. Any doe that has ever freshened, or is being milked regularly (this includes precocious milkers) must be shown in the Senior Division. Any doe under 24 months that has never freshened, and is not being milked regularly must compete in the Junior Division.
12. Base date for computing ages and class numbers is the date of the show you are entering.
13. Exhibitors are encouraged to enter their permanent champions in the Champion Challenge class. Proof of Championship shall be either: (1) The prefix CH, GCH or SGCH as affixed by ADGA on the animal's registration or recordation certificate; or (2) Presentation of the Permanent Champion Certificate Notification Letter issued by ADGA in conjunction with the original registration or recordation certificate. The letter is valid for use until December 31 of the year of issuance.
14. The scratching and/or adding animals must be within the same breed you are scratching. A Saanen for a Saanen will be accepted, but a Saanen for a different breed will not be allowed.
15. Juniors can enter group classes in the Open Doe Show.
16. GROUP CLASSES CLASSIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:
  - Produce of Dam class shall consist of two does, daughters of same dam.
  - Dam & Daughter class shall consist of two does, a doe and one daughter any age.
  - Get of Sire class shall consist of three does, any age, the get of one sire. All animals may be owned by one exhibitor or a combination of exhibitors.
  - Breeders Trio class shall consist of three does any age, all owned and bred by one exhibitor.
  - Herd class shall consist of four does owned by one exhibitor and must consist of three does in milk and one doe of exhibitor's choice.
  - Junior Get of Sire class - 3 does all daughters of one sire, must be under 24 months and have been shown in the Junior Division
  - Junior Produce of Dam class- 2 daughters of same dam, must be under 24 months and have been shown in the Junior Division
  - "Registration papers" must be available to show proof of breeder/owner for all group classes.
