- Passport is a free service and keeps your information from year to year!
- Parents, please create a passport for each child so as they grow, they will have their own passport/records! **DO NOT MAKE ENTRIES FOR MULTIPLE PEOPLE UNDER ONE ACCOUNT; ONE ACCOUNT PER EXHIBITOR**, except when using the Group option.
- Keep passwords simple. Please remember they are case sensitive! Can be one character.
- Mailed in paper entry form from past years will not be accepted.

DCAS policy on all competitive exhibits:

Management reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to limit, restrict, cancel and/or remove (a) any exhibitor, or any of its employees, agents or representatives and/or (b) all or any portion of any "Exhibit" (as defined below) if (i) any exhibitor, or any of its employees, agents or representatives behaves in a manner which is deemed to be Objectionable (as defined below), or (ii) all or any portion of any Exhibit is used to display material of any nature that is deemed to be objectionable. As used herein, the term "objectionable" shall mean, any person or thing which, in Management's sole discretion, is deemed to be (a) disruptive, (b) offensive, (c) inappropriate, (d) unsafe, (e) otherwise not in the best interest of the Fairground, its members or any visitors and/or guests, (f) a detraction from the general character of the event as a whole, (g) inconsistent with the purposes of the event or of the Dutchess County Agricultural Society, (h) inconsistent with any rules and regulations set forth by Management (as may amended from time to time), (i) inconsistent with the values of the Dutchess County Agricultural Society and/or (i) otherwise unacceptable in Management's sole discretion. As used herein, the term "Exhibit" shall include, but is not limited to, any booth, display, exhibit, printed material, equipment, structure, sign, object of art, prop, music, video, picture, method of operation, personnel (behavior and/or attire) and any other thing (tangible or otherwise) used in connection with or comprising a part of any of the foregoing.

In the event of such limitation, restriction, cancellation and/or removal, Management shall not be liable for any refunds or other losses, costs, damages or expenses of any kind whatsoever (including, but not limited to, (i) any exhibition or application fees, (ii) rent, (iii) lost revenues, (iv) direct or indirect damages, losses or expenses, (v) punitive or consequential damages, etc.).

Exhibitors are encouraged to check with Management should they have any questions about the nature of any Exhibit and whether same will be deemed objectionable.

Management reserves the right, at all reasonable times, to inspect all displays.
