## Open Youth Horse Show Class List

**Showmanship:** This class tests the handlers' skills on the ground. Horses should be shown in a halter and lead, English exhibitors will be permitted to show in a bridle.

1. Walk-Trot-Jog Showmanship
2. Beginner Showmanship
3. Youth Showmanship

**Leadline Walk Only:** Open to exhibitors ages 8 & under or those children with special needs. Handler must be 21 years of age or older and properly attired with long pants, boots and appropriate shirt. This Division will be run English & Western combined.

4. Walk Equitation
5. Walk Pleasure

**Leadline Walk-Trot-Jog:** Open to exhibitors ages 8 & under or those children with special needs. Handler must be over 21 and properly attired with long pants, boots and appropriate shirt. This Division will be run English & Western combined.

6. Walk-Trot-Jog Equitation
7. Walk-Trot-Jog Pleasure

**Assisted Walk-Trot-Jog:** Open to riders in their first year of showing that may need verbal assistance from a handler in the ring. Handler will only be allowed to approach horse/rider in an emergency. Handler in ring must be 21 years of age or older. This Division will be run English & Western combined.

**Walk-Trot English:** Open to riders that can walk and trot comfortably in a group. Not eligible for any other divisions other than Walk-Jog Western or Walk-Trot-Jog Gymkhana.

13. Hunter Over Ground Poles

**Beginner English:** Open to riders that have just begun to canter. This division is an intermediate step between Walk-Trot and Youth. Not eligible for any other divisions other than Beginner Western or Beginner Gymkhana. Canter work may be done individually or in a group as seen fit by the judge.

**Youth English:** Open to riders who can Walk-Trot-Canter in a group setting. Not eligible for any other Divisions other than Youth Western and Youth Gymkhana.

21. Hunter Over Fences 2'

**Walk-Jog Western:** Open to riders that can walk and jog comfortably in a group. Not eligible for any other divisions other than Walk-Trot English and Walk-Trot-Jog Gymkhana.

**Beginner Western:** Open to riders that have just begun to lope. This division is an intermediate step in between Walk-Jog and Youth. Not eligible for any other divisions other than Beginner English and Beginner Gymkhana. Lope work may be done individually or in a group as seen fit by the judge.

**Youth Western:** Open to riders that can Walk-Jog-Lope in a group setting. Not eligible for any other divisions other than Youth English and Youth Gymkhana.

**Walk-Trot-Jog Gymkhana:** Open to all Walk-Trot-Jog Riders

**Costume Class:** Open to all Youth Exhibitors. Costumes can be done individually or as a group.

### Championships

Points will be awarded as follows 1<sup>st</sup>- 6<sup>th</sup>: 7-5-4-3-2-1. Ties will be broken using the winner of the Equitation class for English, the Horsemanship class for Western and the Dash class for Gymkhana. Points will be based on a 1 Horse/1 Rider Combination.
